HP Branded Products May Have Problems Running Previous Versions of H3C Software

DESCRIPTION

Many 3Com and H3C products have been re-branded as HP products and retain the same product number (J number) they had when they still had their initial branding. Although the latest software for the product can run on any brand of the products, earlier H3C or 3Com software versions may not be able to run on HP branded products. This is because the products have a device code programmed into them during manufacture, and the new HP device codes are not recognized by the H3C software developed before the re-branding.

If an HP unit is downgraded to an earlier version of H3C code, the application software may fail to recognize the equipment it is running and may not operate correctly. The actual behavior of the product running older code varies depending on the product. Some products operate normally but may display the wrong software version or even the wrong product name and in this case they may continue to be used. Other products may fail to start during boot up resulting in an unusable unit. Recovery of a totally failing unit is possible using the BOOT menu from the console port and re-loading the original compatible application code.

RESOLUTION

HP recommends using the version of software on which the product shipped (or newer). If you have downgraded software versions, HP recommends updating to the latest HP software version.

If there is a compelling reason to run an older version of H3C or 3Com software (such as addition of a new product to a stack running older software), we recommend that you first upgrade to the latest available code from the HP website. This includes a new CLI brand command which can be used to change the branding of the product. Use this command to change the brand of the product to match the older software and then the downgrade to the older software will be successful.
